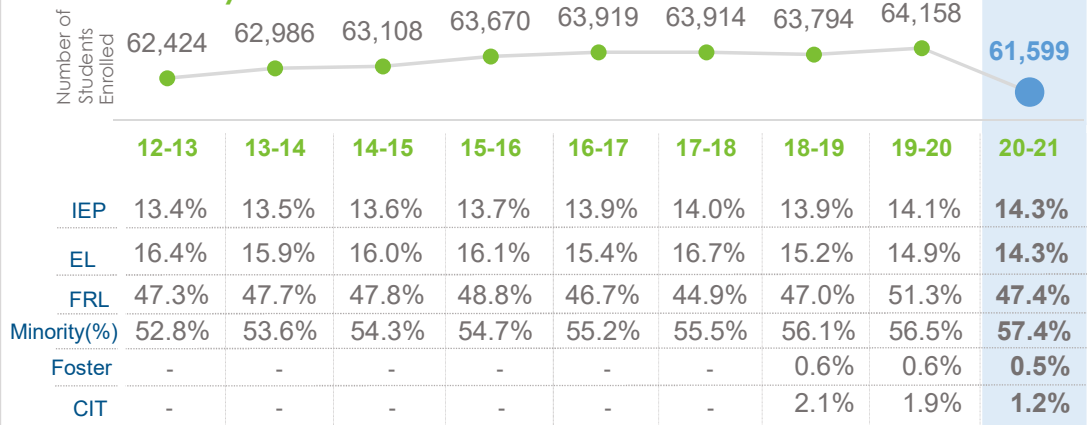

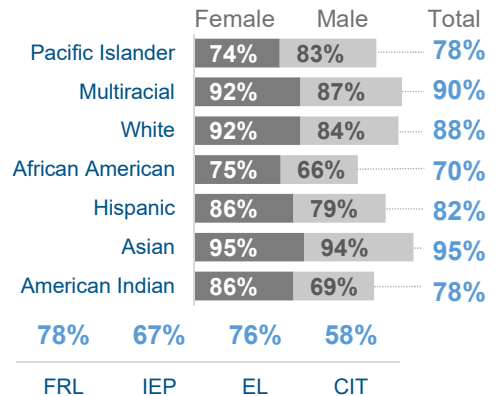

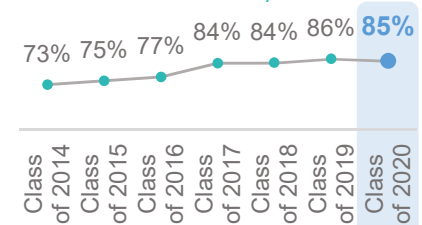

2020 Cohort Graduation Rate **85%**



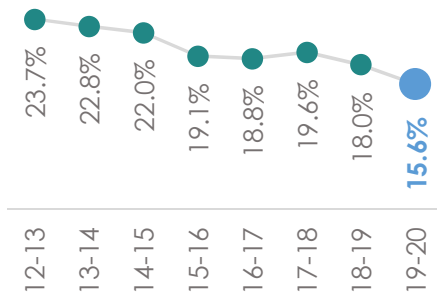
### Graduation Rate by Year
